No time limit to report, 24/7 response available

Restricted Report

-Report to
SARC/VA/MD/Chaplain
-Does not trigger an
investigation

-Victim receives medical
treatment and support
- Command receives non-
identifying information

Unrestricted Report

-Reports made through the
chain of command, legal,
and law enforcement
-Victim receives medical
treatment and support

-Commanders can provide:
Military Protection Order,
Expedited Transfer, Criminal
Investigation
-Offender held accountable
